The city of Cincinnati is located in the southwestern corner of Ohio. Home to more than 330,000 people, it is part of a larger metropolitan area with over two million residents, spanning Ohio, Kentucky and Indiana. Cincinnati hosts 370 *Fortune 500* companies and offers jobs in many industries, including professional/business services, government, education and health services, and manufacturing. According to the 2000 U.S. Census, about 80.6 percent of the population over 25 years old has a high school diploma. About 27.8 percent have a bachelor's degree or higher. Median family income per year is \$38,763, and median home value is \$121,000.
