Lorenzo Simonelli is President and CEO of GE Transportation. The business unit is a global technology leader and supplier to the railroad, marine, drilling, mining and wind industries generating revenues in excess of \$5 billion. GE Transportation provides freight and passenger locomotives, railway signaling and communications systems, information technology solutions, marine engines, drive systems for mining trucks and drills, high-quality replacement parts and value added services. Established more than 100 years ago, GE Transportation is headquartered in Erie, Pennsylvania, and employs approx. 10,000 employees worldwide. He was appointed to his current position in July 2008.

Since January 2007, Lorenzo served as President and CEO of GE Consumer & Industrial (Europe, Middle East & Africa), based in Budapest, Hungary. In this capacity, Lorenzo was also Chairman of the Board of GE Hungary Zrt.

Lorenzo started his career with Mitsubishi Bank in International & Corporate Finance and joined GE in July 1994. He is a graduate of the Financial Management Program (FMP) with assignments in GE International; GE Shared Services; Nuovo Pignone and Consolidated Financial Insurance in a variety of financial and operational roles. In 1997, he joined the Corporate Audit Staff and had assignments in Asia, Europe and the U.S. around both financial and process improvement areas. He progressed to be Executive Audit Manager for European Industrial Businesses in 2001.

In 2002, Lorenzo joined Consumer Products, spending time initially in Cleveland, Ohio and then Louisville, Kentucky as the Financial Planning and Analysis manager, and in April 2004, he became CFO Americas for Consumer & Industrial. In 2005, Lorenzo was appointed to General Manager, Product Management for Appliances, Lighting, Electrical Distribution and Motors.

In November 2009, *Fortune* magazine recognized Lorenzo as one of the most influential business leaders under the age of forty ("40 Under 40").

He is a Business & Economics Graduate from Cardiff University.
