GE in the Philippines dates back to April 1890 when GE's predecessor, Thomas-Houston Electric Company, installed the first electric streetlights along Real Street in Manila. From then on, GE steadily increased its commitment to the country, and in October 1935, incorporated GE Philippines, Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary, to engage in a broad range of manufacturing, trading and service businesses. Today, all of GE's global businesses present in the Philippines are aimed at expanding the company's growth capability and positioning the company for sustained growth. ## GE Volunteers

For more than a century, volunteerism has been a vibrant part of GE's culture. At GE, giving back is both an individual employee activity as well as an organizational effort. We coordinate our resources to create responses tailored to local and individual challenges. Today, the ultimate measure of GE's business is found in the improvements to the lives touched by our work.

In 2007, the GE Volunteers Philippines Council was awarded the GE Volunteers Impact Award in the category of Global Community Day, for its "La Mesa Watershed Tree-Planting" activity, where a total of 150 man-hours were logged, bringing the total of man-hours to 2,000 since the partnership with Bantay Kalikasan was established. GE Philippines has personally adopted 2 hectares of the watershed, planting seedlings totaling to 2,000, with 90% survival rate.

In 2009, we GE Volunteers Philippines Council devoted 11,372 volunteer hours, with 776 volunteers joining in 76 events. In For 2010, a total of 20,334.5 volunteer hours were spent by 983 volunteers in 93 activities. It did not just sustain the momentum in reaching out to communities where GE lives and works, but event surpassed its achievements from previous years.
