General Purpose LED Lighting

- **ENERGY STAR®-qualified LED bulbs** with new sleek (finless) A-line design available in 40- and 60-watt replacement; also next generation 75- and 100-watt replacement LED bulbs will be available later this summer.
- **Daylight LED bulbs**, or 5000K, join GE's low-cost LED line in 40-, 60- and 75-watt replacement bulbs; also available in soft white variations.
- **GE reveal® LED** 40- and 60-watt replacement LED bulbs filter out dull yellow rays, making reds redder and whites whiter.



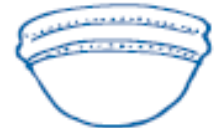
Track & Recessed LED Lighting

- **Reflector indoor floodlight LED bulbs**, R20, BR30 and BR40, are available in soft white, 2700K, and daylight, 5000K; BR30 is available in GE reveal, too.
- **Indoor/outdoor-rated LED spotlights**, or PAR 20, PAR 30 and PAR 38, are all ENERGY STAR-qualified and have a new smooth white design to mirror traditional PAR bulbs.



LED Fixtures

- **Ceiling flush-mount LED fixtures** provide practical LED replacements for enclosed fixtures; available in 9 in. and 12 in. variations with 1000 lumen.
- **LED work light** is a one-piece, 4-foot fixture with 1800 lumens to replace linear work lights, great for shed, basement or garage applications.
- **Recessed downlight LED** 4 in. and 6 in. fixtures are available in soft white, 2700K, daylight, 5000K and GE reveal options.



Decorative LED Lighting

- **Candelabra LED bulbs**, or CAC and CAM shapes for chandelier or sconce lighting, are available in ENERGY STAR-qualified 25- and 40-watt replacements and in frosted or clear options.
- **Globe LED bulbs**, or G16.5 and G25 shapes most commonly used for bathroom vanity or pendant lighting, are available in ENERGY STAR-qualified 25- and 40-watt replacements and in frosted or clear options.
- **Ceiling fan LED bulbs**, or A-15 shapes, are available in 25- and 40-watt replacements and in frosted or clear options.
