GEPAC CONTRIBUTIONS

The General Electric Company Political Action Committee (GEPAC) is an independent, nonpartisan, voluntary fund supported by GE employees who choose to participate in the political process by pooling their resources to support candidates who share the values and goals of the Company and its employees. In the first half of 2021, GEPAC raised \$282,644 from more than 1,300 employees. GEPAC has contributed \$354,500 to candidates and committees in federal elections in the United States. GEPAC also contributed \$20,000 to national governor's associations but has not contributed to state candidates or committees in the first half of 2021.
