

In 2020, GEPAC raised \$700,000 from more than 1,700 employees. GEPAC contributed \$585,000 to candidates and committees in federal elections in the United States. GEPAC also contributed \$70,000 to national governor's associations but did not contribute to state candidates or committees in 2020.
