Peter J. Before joining Integra, Peter was corporate vice president and president of Medication Delivery, Baxter Healthcare. He was responsible for a \$4.8 billion global division of Baxter focused on inpatient pharmaceuticals and devices. He began his career in sales and marketing at Procter and Gamble.
